This study data uses qualitative observation and interviews. Interviews were conducted with 8 students from 230 students who were observed. The interview used an open-ended interview. The results of this study showed that the implementation of online learning has challenges in the form of being hampered by the constraints of electricity costs at school. 3 other students said that it was difficult to get internet access when they were at home to do online classes.

Meanwhile, Francois (2020) stated that online learning is a term used to describe distance or correspondence courses offered over the Internet. This educational method is growing in popularity as a cost-effective method of providing access to education for large populations. The courses offered through online learning cover a wide range of subjects, audiences, and prices. Richards (2020) stated that existing technology at this time has enabled students to learn directly through technology.

RECOMMENDATION

For Student- The students are suggested to be more active in group work, being passive does not help complete the task. The students can form discussion groups to exchange opinions or ask questions about materials that are difficult to understand in their preferred ways. It can make students more active.

For next Researcher - The researchers of this study recommends other researchers to conduct a similar topic with different research approach, such as using quantitative approach or mixed method. The researcher suggested that they get wider different setting and further develop this research specifically and make this research to be more depth.
